

Mentorship

PCEBP organizes mentorship meetings with trainees that completed the Comprehensive Systematic Review Training Program (CS-RTP). These meetings allow experiences sharing in conducting systematic reviews following the JBI methodology (from title to final report).

The 7th PCEBP Mentorship Meeting took place in June 1st 2017 at the Health Sciences Research Unit: Nursing (UICISA: E), Nursing School of Coimbra. Sixteen trainees participated (Figure 2). Two trainees from Costa Rica participated in part of the meeting through Skype. Two protocols of systematic reviews and one title proposal for were presented and discussed.






Figure 7. Number of countries that integrate the International Organizations of which UICISA: E is a collaborating member. SSH → Society for Simulation in Healthcare; IGM Internacional → Gineste-Marescotti International Institute; ALADEFE → Latin American Association of Schools and Colleges of Nursing; RESM - LP → Nursing Maternal Health Network - Portuguese Language; EIP-AHA → European Innovation Partnership in Active and Healthy Ageing; JBC → Joanna Briggs Collaboration; STTI → Sigma Theta Tau International; WHO → World Health Organization; IREFREA → European Institute for the Study of Risk Factors in Children and Adolescents; ICPHR → International Collaboration for Participatory Health Research.

Figure 7 shows the international organizations network with which UICISA: E / ESEnfC collaborate and the number of countries that integrate them.
