

## > PCEBP – partner of a new European funded project

The Strategic Partnership in Innovation and Development of Evidence-Based Healthcare (SPIDER) project was funded within the Erasmus+ program and integrated into Key Action 2 - Cooperation for innovation and the exchange of good practices (Figure 4).



Objectives: To decrease the gap between research and practice in healthcare and support the international cooperation of professionals in healthcare. To address the needs of improving skills and qualifications of European project partners in Evidence-Based Health Care and critical thinking, especially in the translation/implementation and use of evidence in healthcare clinical practice.

**Duration:** 24 months (1. 9. 2019 – 31. 8. 2021)

Partners: Czech Republic (Applicant organization), Portugal (PCEBP/UICISA: E/ESEnfC), Romania (Ordinul Asistentilor Medicali Generalisti, Moaselor Si Asistentilor Medicali Din Romania-Filiala Bucuresti), Spain (Instituto de Salud Carlos III), and United Kingdom (Cardiff University)




Figure 5. Committee of Directors' Meeting.


