5th Axis – Researchers' Training

The main goal of the Researchers' Training is to promote the researchers' capacity, keeping relevant training activity from research initiation to advanced research in cooperation with International Universities.

- The Young Researcher Window is an initiative of the UICISA: E. The students sent their proposals after they experienced Introduction to Research activities.
- Through the Young Researcher Window, students have the opportunity to voluntarily get acquainted with the unit facilities and Mission, participate in activities and access important documents.
- The Initiation to Research Rotation (RII) is an initiative of the UICISA: E. It consists of research training of students in an initiation level.

6th Axis – Ethics

The Ethics Committee, formed in 2010, has been assigned to oversee the compliance of ethics standards and procedures within the projects inside the UICISA: E as well as outside projects.

- The Ethics Committee consists of five members, including three outside members.
- The Ethics Committee meets monthly and assesses the requests received the month before

Next UICISA: E biennial, 5th Congress on Nursing Research of Ibero-American and Portuguese-speaking Countries, will be held in June 2016.

This year, the event will be enriched by the integration of the International Symposium on Evidence-Based Health Care.
